- 4. What methods, other than using decisions from the human rights commissions, could be used to promote equality in the workplace?
- 5. How were Tawney Meiorin's rights under the Charter violated when she was dismissed? Do you agree with the Supreme Court's decision? Why or why not?
- 6. What occupations do you think would be justified in imposing discriminatory hiring standards, based on the Supreme Court's requirement of "undue hardship" on the employer? What would the standards be?
- 7. What does the term glass ceiling refer to? Which social values and forces do you think created glass ceilings?
- 8. Do you think the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child has made a difference in the lives of children in Canada and other countries? Explain.
- 9. How are children protected in Canada and the Yukon.?
- 10. Is child poverty a human rights issue? Explain your viewpoint with reference to the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child.
- 11. Why do you think Canada has made so little progress since 1989 in ending child poverty?
